THE ENGINEERING EDUCATION INCENTIVE AWARD

The *Engineering Education Incentive Award* is one of the primary awards given by WSPE

Who is eligible to receive the award?

Students transitioning from a Washington community college into an engineering program in the state of Washington accredited by the Engineering Accreditation Commission of the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology, 111 Market Place, Suite 1050, Baltimore, MD 21202-4102

How are recipients selected?

Candidates are nominated for the **Incentive Award** by the faculty of their community college. Nominations are made on the basis of academic accomplishments and interest in pursuing a career in engineering, most favorably through a program in preparation for a career as a Professional Engineer. Final recommendation for the award is made by the Washington Society of Professional Engineers.

What Community Colleges are Eligible to nominate candidates?

Each community college and ABET/TAC accredited program located in the state of Washington is eligible to nominate a student candidate.

When are nominations due?

The Nomination Package for a student candidate must be provided by **April 1** of each year to the **Washington Society of Professional Engineers, Attn: Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 1206, Sumas, WA 98295-1206.**

What must be included with the nomination?

The community college or ABET/TAC program must submit the nomination including:

- 1) A letter of recommendation from an appropriate faculty member.
- 2) The nominee's academic record
- 3) A letter from the candidate indicating his/her particular educational and career interest.

When would the successful nominee be notified?

The final selection will be made in late Spring. A letter indicating our intent to award would be provided to the submitting school and to the successful nominees prior to the spring graduation ceremonies. The actual award would be provided at the time the student enrolls in the ABET/EAC accredited engineering program.

How many awards would be given? How much are the awards?

The amount and number of awards will be determined each year by the Foundation. The awards will be for not less than \$ 1,000. Generally there will be not less than two awards given per year.

Can the successful candidate apply for an award after receiving the first?

No, the Engineering Education Incentive Awards are for one year only.
